


# MatLab 2021b

This page will help you download, install and activate Matlab on your personal computer


**This document is for Windows users. Users of other systems can download Matlab following the same steps, but installation may be slightly different.**

First of all, you'll need an account at Mathworks (the publishers of Matlab)



Click on **Sign In** at the top right



Fill in your details, or at the bottom click on **Create Account** to sign up



When filling in your **email address** make sure you use your University one, as this is how Mathworks will identify your free license allowance.







Now you can select **Download Your Products Now**. It should show Matlab 2021b as the latest release.




Choose the version appropriate to your computer (these steps will reflect the Windows edition)




Run the installer when it has completed downloading

## Installation


Run the installer and sign in as m11561@surrey.ac.uk.




Once launched, the installer will unpack itself and being the installation wizard




Click **Next** to log in with the account you created earlier




Accept the license by clicking **Next**




Provide your credentials and click **Next**




If you associated the license correctly, then you should see just one to select, so click **Next**




Accept the default installation location by clicking **Next**




You can now choose which modules you want. You're entitled to them all, but it gets pretty big! Click **Next**




Choose whether you want a desktop and/or a start menu shortcut and click **Next**




Nearly there! This is your installation summary. Click **Install** if you're happy.



Installation will now commence. Depending on how many modules you selected, this could take a while




Click **Next** to move on from the notes




Installation is complete! You'll need to activate Matlab before you can use it.

Leave the box ticked and click **Next**


## Matlab Activation




Click **Next** to get started
