HONORARY GRADUAND

STEVE LILLYWHITE, CBE CEREMONY E

Steve Lillywhite began his music career in 1972 as a tape operator at Phonogram Studios. He produced early demos for Ultravox, which paved the way for his first major success, the 1978 hit single Hong Kong Garden by Siouxsie and the Banshees.

Throughout the 1980s, Steve produced hits for XTC, The Members, Joan Armatrading, and Peter Gabriel. He also embarked on a 45-year collaboration with U2, shaping classics like New Year's Day, With or Without You, and Vertigo.

His production credits expanded to include Big Country, Simple Minds, Morrissey, The Rolling Stones, and Talking Heads. In 1987, he produced Fairytale of New York by The Pogues featuring Kirsty MacColl—now considered the UK's most beloved Christmas song.

In the 1990s, Steve relocated to the United States, where he contributed to multi-platinum albums for Dave Matthews Band, Phish, Counting Crows, and Chris Cornell.

Following Kirsty MacColl's passing in 2000, he returned to London and spent a decade working with Mercury and Columbia Records before refocusing on production. His later projects included Matchbox Twenty, Thirty Seconds to Mars, Jason Mraz, and Crowded House. In 2006, he was honoured with the Grammy Award for Producer of the Year.

In recognition of his contributions to music, Steve was awarded a CBE in 2012.



HONORARY GRADUAND

JOHN MULLEN - CEREMONY F

John has extensive experience in international transportation and logistics, with more than two decades in senior positions with some of the world's largest transport and infrastructure companies. He has lived or worked in 13 countries.

From 2011 to 2016, John was the Chief Executive Officer of Asciano, Australia's largest ports and rail operator. Prior to this, John spent 15 years with DHL Express, a US\$20b company employing over 100,000 people in 220 countries, where he served as the global Chief Executive Officer from 2005 to 2009. Before DHL, John spent 10 years with the TNT Group, including four years as the Chief Executive Officer of TNT Express Worldwide based in the Netherlands.

Currently, John is the Chairman of Qantas (Since 2024), Brambles Ltd (Since 2020), and Treasury Wine Estates (Since 2023). He is also a director of Brookfield Infrastructure Partners L.P. (From 2021) and is Chairman of the Australian National Maritime Museum (from 2019).

Former Directorships and appointments include Chairman of Telstra Group Ltd from 2016 to 2023, Chairman of Toll Holdings (2017-2022), Chair of the US National Foreign Trade Council in Washington (2008-2010), and Member of the UNICEF Task Force on Workplace Gender Discrimination and Harassment (2018-2019)



HONORARY GRADUAND

LIM HUA MIN – CEREMONY G

Mr Lim Hua Min is founder and Executive Chairman of PhillipCapital Group which has expanded from Singapore over the years to 16 countries with assets under custody of US\$70 billion. He is also the Chairman of IFS Capital Limited and its subsidiary, ECICS Limited. A pioneer in Singapore's financial industry, he has significantly shaped the nation's capital markets.

With extensive experience in financial governance, Mr Lim has served on the board of Inland Revenue Authority of Singapore and contributed to various Stock Exchange of Singapore (SES) committees. In 1997, as Chairman of SES Review Committee, he led key reforms to enhance Singapore's global market competitiveness, earning him the Public Service Medal in 1999.

Mr Lim's achievements have been widely recognised. In 2014, he was honoured as an "IBF Distinguished Fellow" by the Institute of Banking and Finance for his exemplary professionalism and leadership. In 2015, he received the Asia Lifetime Achievement Award at the Futures & Options World Awards, and in 2017, he was named Businessman of the Year by the Singapore Business Times. His vision continues to inspire and shape the financial sector in Singapore and beyond.

Mr Lim holds a Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Chemical Engineering from the University of Surrey and a Master's in Operations Research and Management Studies from Imperial College, London.



HONORARY GRADUAND

ALAN PARKER, CBE - CEREMONY H

Alan was a pioneer of the University graduating in 1969 with a BSc in Hotel and Catering Administration, the second year of any degree awards. His son Charlie is also a Surrey alumnus.

Alan believes his education at Surrey and later at Harvard AMP was critical for his fifty-year career in hospitality in the UK, Europe, Middle East and the USA.

Alan was CEO of Whitbread plc a FTSE 100 company which he transformed to become the UK's largest hospitality group with Premier Inn, Marriott Hotels, Costa Coffee and several hundred pub restaurants.

Previously Alan had been Senior Vice President of Holiday Inn Europe, Middle East and Africa based in Brussels. Alan

has also served on the Boards of Burger King Worldwide (USA), Jumeirah Group LLC (UAE), VisitBritain, and was Chairman and President of the British Hospitality Association.

Stepping down from executive responsibilities Alan went on to Chair several public and private companies - Darty (France), Parkdean Resorts and Mothercare from which he retired in 2018.

Recognised with the CBE for his success in UK Tourism and various other awards. He now serves as a local Borough Councillor and is Chairman of the Duke and Duchess of Edinburgh's charity trust.







A LITTLE HISTORY

NEARLY 60 YEARS OF SURREY DEGREES

The University of Surrey was established on 9 September 1966 with the grant of its Royal Charter, but its roots go back to 1891, when its forerunner Battersea Polytechnic Institute was founded to teach poorer London inhabitants. As its academic reputation grew, the renamed Battersea College of Technology moved to Guildford in the 1960s, where it became a university awarding its own degrees.

Since July 1970, by kind permission of the Dean and Chapter, degree conferment ceremonies have been held in Guildford Cathedral. On these occasions it is used as a secular building.




The mace

The University mace was designed and crafted by Desmond Clen Murphy and used ceremonially for the first time at the Installation as Chancellor of the Rt Hon the Lord Robens of Woldingham in 1966.

The mace is made of silver and walnut wood, with the shield of the University coat of arms on its head in colour, and with the shields of the coat of arms of Surrey County Council, Guildford Borough Council and Battersea Polytechnic Institute engraved in silver underneath. The embroidered coat of arms on the mace table, carried out in metallic thread, French knots, applied leathers and various materials, was created by Christine Habib, a former student of the Hampton School of Embroidery.

The mace was presented to Guildford Cathedral for permanent display on 13 July 1997.



The arms of the University of Surrey

The University of Surrey coat of arms commemorates the University's move from London to Guildford. The woolpacks on the shield are taken from the arms of the Borough of Guildford, while the blue and gold chequers and mantling are from the arms of the former Earls of Surrey. The swords, an allusion to the arms of the City of London, are taken from the shield of Battersea Polytechnic.

The blazon of the University's coat of arms, which was granted in 1966, is topped by a stag resting its right leg on an upturned key. The stag denotes the medieval royal hunting park on which our leafy Stag Hill site has been developed, while the key is a heraldic symbol of learning.

The coat of arms is an elegant symbol of our reputation and standing.

ACADEMIC DRESS

Every university has a distinctive set of academic robes for the degrees it awards and special ceremonial robes for the high officers of the university. The blue brocade that features in the hoods of all our robes is unique to Surrey and distinguishes us from other universities.

GRADUATE ROBES

Undergraduate and masters degrees

Graduates wear a black gown and a black cloth mortar board. Hoods are usually fully lined with blue brocade and vary in design depending on whether the award is undergraduate or postgraduate.



Diploma and certificate awards

Diplomates wear a black gown and a black cloth mortar board. Postgraduate hoods are fully lined with blue brocade, with a plain white trim. Undergraduate hoods have a blue brocade and plain white trim.



Doctorate awards

Gowns are in cardinal red with blue brocade on the front facings. The hoods are cardinal red, fully lined with University brocade and have a ribbon trim rebated from the outside edge of the hood. The hat is a black cloth bonnet with red cord and tassels, with the exception of Doctors of Letters, Science and Medicine where the cord and tassels are gold.

The colour of the trim on the hoods denotes the type of degree:

- Bachelor and Master of Arts, Doctor of Letters** - Red ribbon
- Bachelor, Master and Doctor of Education** - Green ribbon
- Bachelor, Master and Doctor of Engineering** - Grey ribbon
- Bachelor and Master of Laws** - Purple ribbon
- Bachelor and Master of Music** - White brocade
- Bachelor, Master and Doctor of Science** - No trim
- Bachelor of Veterinary Medicine** - Pale yellow ribbon
- Master of Business** - Ruby ribbon
- Master of Chemistry / of Computing / of Mathematics / in Physics / in Science (MSci)** - Pale blue ribbon


