## GUEST SPEAKER

### ODALINE DE LA MARTINEZ – CEREMONY A

Odaline de la Martinez is an internationally renowned conductor, composer and music director, celebrated for her pioneering work in contemporary music and her championing of women and Latin American composers. Born in Cuba and raised in the United States, she studied at Tulane University before moving to the UK to attend the Royal Academy of Music. In 1977, she earned a Master of Music (MMus) in composition from the University of Surrey. In recognition of her outstanding contribution to music, she was awarded a Doctor Honoris Causa degree by the University of Surrey in 2019. In 1984, she made history as the first woman to conduct a BBC Promenade Concert at the Royal Albert Hall.

In 1976, Odaline co-founded Lontano, the London-based contemporary music ensemble, which has since become known for its adventurous programming and commitment to underrepresented voices. She later established the record label LORELT (Lontano Records Ltd) to record and promote works by women and

ethnically diverse composers, helping to reshape the classical music canon.

As a composer, her output includes operas, orchestral, chamber and vocal works, often infused with elements of her Cuban heritage. Her opera *Imoinda*, based on the untold story behind Aphra Behn's *Oroonoko*, is a powerful example of her interest in narratives of identity and resistance. Other significant works include her *Cuban Dances*, *Three Afro Cuban Poems* for unaccompanied choir, *Four Afro Cuban Poems* for Mezzo and string orchestra, and *Memorias* for ensemble.

Odaline has conducted major orchestras and ensembles across the UK, Europe, and the Americas, earning widespread admiration for her visionary artistry and tireless advocacy.

She has received numerous accolades throughout her career for services to music and continues to be a formidable force in shaping the future of classical music.



# HONORARY GRADUAND

## LORD JIM O'NEILL OF GATLEY – CEREMONY B

Alumnus Lord Jim O'Neill is a globally recognised economist, investor, and public policy leader. He is Chair of Northern Gritstone and the Northern Powerhouse Partnership, supporting innovation and economic growth across northern England. Formerly Commercial Secretary to the Treasury (2015-16), he helped shape the UK's regional devolution strategy and was instrumental in promoting the "Northern Powerhouse" concept.

Best known for coining the term *BRIC* during his tenure as Chief Economist at Goldman Sachs (1995-2013), Lord O'Neill is a thought leader on global economic trends, emerging markets, and public finance. He chaired the Cities Growth Commission and led the influential

Review on Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR) for Prime Minister David Cameron, later co-authoring *Superbugs: An Arms Race Against Bacteria*. He continues to advocate for global health solutions, particularly in diagnostics and AMR policy.

An advocate for education and social mobility, Lord O'Neill co-founded SHINE, an educational charity, and has held board roles with Chatham House and Bruegel. His contributions span economics, health, and philanthropy, earning him honorary titles and fellowships across numerous academic and professional institutions. He is a Crossbench member of the House of Lords.



# HONORARY GRADUAND

## ROBERT EARL – CEREMONY D

Robert Earl is a British-American hospitality entrepreneur and brand visionary, best known as the founder and Chairman of Earl Enterprises and the iconic Planet Hollywood International. After graduating, Robert moved to Orlando, Florida in the 1980s, where his global hospitality group is now based. With decades of leadership across the food & beverage, lodging, gaming, and entertainment sectors, Robert has been a transformative force in the hospitality industry.

In 1997, Time Magazine named him one of America's 25 Most Influential People. His portfolio includes founding Virtual Dining Concepts (VDC), a trailblazing

platform in the virtual restaurant space. In 2025, he launched AC Barbecue alongside actors Anthony Anderson and Cedric The Entertainer, opening its first physical location in Los Angeles with plans for expansion.

Robert continues to license the Planet Hollywood brand globally and advises Boston University's School of Hospitality Administration. A brand builder and strategic thinker, he is celebrated for his innovation in dining experiences and customer engagement. Alongside his wife Tricia, Robert remains a prominent figure in the evolving landscape of hospitality entrepreneurship.



# HONORARY GRADUAND

## DATO DR HASNITA HASHIM – CEREMONY E

Dr. Hasnita Dato' Hashim is an accomplished global finance leader and a pioneering figure in Islamic finance. With over three decades of experience across the UK, US, Middle East, and Asia, she currently chairs Maybank Investment Banking Group and Maybank Asset Management Group. She also sits on the main board of Malayan Banking Berhad, Malaysia's largest bank, where she leads the Nomination and Remuneration Committee.

Dr. Hasnita was instrumental in introducing Islamic Asset-Backed Sukuk to global markets, starting with a USD 1.25 billion financing project

for Malaysia's Light Rail Transit system. She also co-founded Islamic mortgage companies in the US and Saudi Arabia, collaborating with institutions such as Freddie Mac to originate over USD 5 billion in loans. In 1998, she founded IslamiQ, the world's first Islamic fintech platform.

A champion of value-based finance, she integrates ESG principles with Islamic financial ethics to promote fairness, governance, and inclusion. She also serves on the boards of Duopharma Biotech and MRANTI, and was formerly Chair of MARA and a member of Malaysia's National Economic Action Council.







## A LITTLE HISTORY

# NEARLY 60 YEARS OF SURREY DEGREES

The University of Surrey was established on 9 September 1966 with the grant of its Royal Charter, but its roots go back to 1891, when its forerunner Battersea Polytechnic Institute was founded to teach poorer London inhabitants. As its academic reputation grew, the renamed Battersea College of Technology moved to Guildford in the 1960s, where it became a university awarding its own degrees.

Since July 1970, by kind permission of the Dean and Chapter, degree conferment ceremonies have been held in Guildford Cathedral. On these occasions it is used as a secular building.




### The mace

The University mace was designed and crafted by Desmond Clen Murphy and used ceremonially for the first time at the Installation as Chancellor of the Rt Hon the Lord Robens of Woldingham in 1966.

The mace is made of silver and walnut wood, with the shield of the University coat of arms on its head in colour, and with the shields of the coat of arms of Surrey County Council, Guildford Borough Council and Battersea Polytechnic Institute engraved in silver underneath. The embroidered coat of arms on the mace table, carried out in metallic thread, French knots, applied leathers and various materials, was created by Christine Habib, a former student of the Hampton School of Embroidery.

The mace was presented to Guildford Cathedral for permanent display on 13 July 1997.



### The arms of the University of Surrey

The University of Surrey coat of arms commemorates the University's move from London to Guildford. The woolpacks on the shield are taken from the arms of the Borough of Guildford, while the blue and gold chequers and mantling are from the arms of the former Earls of Surrey. The swords, an allusion to the arms of the City of London, are taken from the shield of Battersea Polytechnic.

The blazon of the University's coat of arms, which was granted in 1966, is topped by a stag resting its right leg on an upturned key. The stag denotes the medieval royal hunting park on which our leafy Stag Hill site has been developed, while the key is a heraldic symbol of learning.

The coat of arms is an elegant symbol of our reputation and standing.

# ACADEMIC DRESS

Every university has a distinctive set of academic robes for the degrees it awards and special ceremonial robes for the high officers of the university. The blue brocade that features in the hoods of all our robes is unique to Surrey and distinguishes us from other universities.

## GRADUATE ROBES

### Undergraduate and masters degrees

Graduates wear a black gown and a black cloth mortar board. Hoods are usually fully lined with blue brocade and vary in design depending on whether the award is undergraduate or postgraduate.



### Diploma and certificate awards

Diplomates wear a black gown and a black cloth mortar board. Postgraduate hoods are fully lined with blue brocade, with a plain white trim. Undergraduate hoods have a blue brocade and plain white trim.



### Doctorate awards

Gowns are in cardinal red with blue brocade on the front facings. The hoods are cardinal red, fully lined with University brocade and have a ribbon trim rebated from the outside edge of the hood. The hat is a black cloth bonnet with red cord and tassels, with the exception of Doctors of Letters, Science and Medicine where the cord and tassels are gold.

The colour of the trim on the hoods denotes the type of degree:

- Bachelor and Master of Arts, Doctor of Letters** - Red ribbon
- Bachelor, Master and Doctor of Education** - Green ribbon
- Bachelor, Master and Doctor of Engineering** - Grey ribbon
- Bachelor and Master of Laws** - Purple ribbon
- Bachelor and Master of Music** - White brocade
- Bachelor, Master and Doctor of Science** - No trim
- Bachelor of Veterinary Medicine** - Pale yellow ribbon
- Master of Business** - Ruby ribbon
- Master of Chemistry / of Computing / of Mathematics / in Physics / in Science (MSci)** - Pale blue ribbon

- Master of Fine Arts** - Strawberry ribbon
- Master of Research** - Apricot ribbon
- Master of Philosophy** - Blue brocade lining extending to the outside edge of the hood

- Doctor of Medicine** - Burnt orange ribbon
- Doctor of Philosophy** - No ribbon trim
- Doctor of Psychology** - Pale blue ribbon trim rebated from the outside edge of the hood.


