FOLLEY OGUNDELE - CEREMONY A

Folley Ogundele is an international commercial executive and currently serves as Head of Enterprise at OpenAI, helping global organisations adopt AI responsibly and at scale.

Folley's foundation was built at the University of Surrey, where he studied BSc (Hons) Business Management (2004-2008). Surrey stood out for its well-rounded student experience, combining strong academics, a vibrant community, and a placement year that genuinely prepares you for the real world. While at Surrey, he also learned what it means to lead by example and bring others with you. He represented Team GB American Football during his time at Surrey, and in 2008 was awarded Sportsperson of the Year. Those experiences cemented lessons he still lives by: master the

fundamentals, persevere through setbacks, and keep aiming higher than feels comfortable.

Prior to his leadership role at OpenAI, he was Global VP at Wise, Head of Europe at Stripe and held leadership roles at American Express and IBM. He is known for scaling category-defining technology companies, building high-performing teams and opening doors for underrepresented talent.

Folley earned an MBA at Imperial College London and is also an active angel investor and venture partner. He is proud to serve on the Surrey Business School Advisory Board, supporting the School's leadership as it shapes programmes, partnerships and student outcomes.



HONORARY GRADUAND

PETER VENISON CVO - CEREMONY B

Peter Venison is a distinguished hotelier and entrepreneur. He began in 1963 at London's newly opened Carlton Tower and quickly rose to General Manager at just 27, demonstrating the drive and determination that would define his global career.

In 1971 he moved to South Africa as Managing Director of Southern Sun Hotels, building the group into the largest in the Southern Hemisphere and shaping Sun City into a world-class resort. He later led Hotel Properties of America in the United States, co-founding the Smith & Wollensky restaurant brand, and delivered landmark projects including Cap Juluca in Anguilla and the Atlantis resort in the Bahamas.

As Managing Director of Sun International and Royal Resorts, he oversaw around 80 hotels and multiple casinos worldwide, leading teams and creating opportunities across more than 110 countries.

Since retiring from full-time leadership in 2000, Peter has continued to inspire through international consultancy, the Duke of Edinburgh Cup charity golf tournament, and his memoir, *Sol*, sharing insights from a lifetime in hospitality. Appointed a Commander of the Royal Victorian Order in 2020, his career demonstrates how skill, commitment, and perseverance can create meaningful impact - a model for graduates as they begin their own careers.



GUEST SPEAKER

JEREMY SWIFT - CEREMONY C

Jeremy Swift is an Emmy Award nominee for Outstanding Supporting Actor in a Comedy Series for his acclaimed performance as Leslie Higgins in the global hit *Ted Lasso*. He has appeared in all four seasons of the award-winning Apple TV+ comedy and received a 2021 Hollywood Critics Association TV Award for Best Supporting Actor in a Streaming Comedy Series.

Swift is widely recognised for his work across British television, with regular roles in *Downton Abbey*, *Foyle's War*, *The Durrells* and *The Smoking Room*. His extensive television credits also include *All Creatures Great & Small*, *Sweetpea*, *Doc Martin*, *Wanderlust*, *Plebs*, *Strike*; *The Silkworm* and *National Treasure*.

On film, Swift appeared in *Disney's Mary Poppins Returns* alongside Emily Blunt and Meryl Streep. His other film credits

include *Jupiter Ascending*, *Fred Claus*, *Oliver Twist* directed by Roman Polanski, *Amazing Grace*, *Gosford Park*, *Dark Blue World*, *Boy A* and *To Kill a King*. Upcoming and recent projects include *Goodbye June* (Netflix) and *Welcome to the Fishbowl*.

On stage, Swift led the Olivier Award-winning production of *The Railway Children* at London's King's Cross Theatre. His other theatre credits include *The Importance of Being Earnest* (Vaudeville Theatre), *The 39 Steps* (Criterion Theatre), *The Way of the World* (Chichester Festival Theatre), and *What the Butler Saw* at the National Theatre.

Swift's career spans film, television, theatre and radio, establishing him as one of Britain's most versatile and accomplished character actors.





A LITTLE HISTORY

60 YEARS OF SURREY DEGREES

The University of Surrey was established on 9 September 1966 with the grant of its Royal Charter, but its roots go back to 1891, when its forerunner, Battersea Polytechnic Institute, was founded.

As its academic reputation grew, it was renamed Battersea College of Technology and moved to Guildford in the 1960s, where it became a university awarding its own degrees.

And degree conferment ceremonies like yours have been held at Guildford Cathedral since 1970.

The mace

The University mace was designed and crafted by Desmond Clen Murphy and used ceremonially for the first time at the Installation as Chancellor of the Rt Hon the Lord Robens of Woldingham in 1966.

The mace is made of silver and walnut wood, with the shield of the University coat of arms on its head in colour, and with the shields of the coat of arms of Surrey County Council, Guildford Borough Council and Battersea Polytechnic Institute engraved in silver underneath. The embroidered coat of arms on the mace table, carried out in metallic thread, French knots, applied leathers and various materials, was created by Christine Habib, a former student of the Hampton School of Embroidery.

The mace was presented to Guildford Cathedral for permanent display on 13 July 1997.



The arms of the University of Surrey

The University of Surrey coat of arms commemorates the University's move from London to Guildford. The woolpacks on the shield are taken from the arms of the Borough of Guildford, while the blue and gold chequers and mantling are from the arms of the former Earls of Surrey. The swords, an allusion to the arms of the City of London, are taken from the shield of Battersea Polytechnic.

The blazon of the University's coat of arms, which was granted in 1966, is topped by a stag resting its right leg on an upturned key. The stag denotes the medieval royal hunting park on which our leafy Stag Hill site has been developed, while the key is a heraldic symbol of learning.

The coat of arms is an elegant symbol of our reputation and standing.

ACADEMIC DRESS

Every university has a distinctive set of academic robes for the degrees it awards and special ceremonial robes for the high officers of the university. The blue brocade that features in the hoods of all our robes is unique to Surrey and distinguishes us from other universities.

GRADUATE ROBES

Undergraduate and masters degrees

Graduates wear a black gown and a black cloth mortar board. Hoods are usually fully lined with blue brocade and vary in design depending on whether the award is undergraduate or postgraduate.



Diploma and certificate awards

Diplomates wear a black gown and a black cloth mortar board. Postgraduate hoods are fully lined with blue brocade, with a plain white trim. Undergraduate hoods have a blue brocade and plain white trim.



Doctorate awards

Gowns are in cardinal red with blue brocade on the front facings. The hoods are cardinal red, fully lined with University brocade and have a ribbon trim rebated from the outside edge of the hood. The hat is a black cloth bonnet with red cord and tassels, with the exception of Doctors of Letters, Science and Medicine where the cord and tassels are gold.

The colour of the trim on the hoods denotes the type of degree:

Bachelor and Master of Arts, Doctor of Letters - Red ribbon

Bachelor, Master and Doctor of Education - Green ribbon

Bachelor, Master and Doctor of Engineering - Grey ribbon

Bachelor and Master of Laws - Purple ribbon

Bachelor and Master of Music - White brocade

Bachelor and Master of Science - Pink ribbon

Bachelor of Veterinary Medicine - Pale yellow ribbon

Master of Business - Ruby ribbon

Master of Chemistry / of Computing / of Mathematics / in Physics / in Science (MSci) - Pale blue ribbon
