GUEST SPEAKER

DOMINIQUE SMITH - CEREMONY B

Dominique is a barrister at Deka Chambers, specialising in Personal Injury, Clinical Negligence, Travel Law and Inquests. She was called to the Bar in 2016. In 2025, Dominique was appointed as a Deputy District Judge on the South Eastern Circuit, at the age of 34.

She is ranked as a Leading Junior in the Legal 500 2026 in Clinical Negligence (Band 4), Inquests and Inquiries (Band 5) and Personal Injury (Band 5). She is also ranked as a Leading Junior in Chambers and Partners 2026 in Travel: International Personal Injury (Band 2) and Inquests & Inquiries (Band 5). Dominique was further ranked in the Lexology Index 2026 in Aviation and Travel.

Dominique has authored and co-authored several textbooks, including Saggerson on Travel Law and Litigation

(7th Edition) (2022), 'A Practical Guide to Cross-Border Clinical Negligence' (2023). She also co-authors the holiday claims chapter in Kemp & Kemp: Quantum of Damages.

Dominique is the current Chair of the Medical Negligence Special Interest Group at the Pan European Organisation of Personal Injury Lawyers (PEOPIL). She is an elected member of the Inner Temple's Bar Liaison Committee (BLC) and is a committee member of the Inns of Court Alliance for Women (ICAW).

Dominique began her law career at the University of Surrey, graduating in 2015 with a First Class Honours Degree. She completed her Bar Professional Training Course (BPTC) at the University of Law (London Bloomsbury) in 2016 and commenced pupillage in 2017.



GUEST SPEAKER

LUCY VINCENT - CEREMONY C

Lucy Vincent is the founder and CEO of Food Behind Bars, the UK charity leading efforts to improve prison food and food education. Originally trained as a journalist and with a background in hospitality, she founded the organisation in 2016 after investigating prison food standards and recognising the profound impact food has on dignity, wellbeing and rehabilitation.

Under her leadership, Food Behind Bars has grown from a campaign into a nationally recognised systems-change organisation and the only charity in the world solely dedicated to transforming prison food. Since becoming a registered charity in 2020, the organisation has delivered programmes in prisons across

England, improved food quality for thousands of people in custody and helped shape the new Food in Prisons Policy Framework due to come into legislation in 2026.

A Churchill Fellow, Lucy has studied prison food systems internationally, including in Scandinavia and the United States, and is widely recognised as a leading voice on food justice and prison reform. Her work has been featured by the BBC, The Guardian and Vogue, and she has received numerous honours, including the Fortnum & Mason Food & Drink Impact Award and recognition as one of the UK's Inspirational Women of the Year.



GUEST SPEAKER

DR IMOGEN PARSONS - CEREMONY D

Dr Imogen Parsons is a Senior Civil Servant, based in the Cabinet Office, where she leads cross government work on the Indo-Pacific, Africa, Latin America and Caribbean.

Her career has spanned government departments - the Ministry of Defence, Foreign and Commonwealth Office and Department for International Development - where she has led teams on conflict and crisis management, resilience, research and innovation, and deployed to Afghanistan as a civilian adviser to the Commander of the International Security Assistance Force.

She has also spent time in the non-profit sector, with UNICEF in Madagascar, and with Save the Children leading emergency responses in Libya, DRC and Horn of Africa. She was also recently seconded to RUSI, as Director of their terrorism and conflict programme. She holds a PhD in international relations from LSE, on conflict and state building in Angola, MSc in Development Studies from SOAS and MA(Cantab) in Modern Languages from Cambridge.

She has been a Trustee of Saferworld for three years and is a Visiting Professor of Practice in the Politics Department at Surrey University.



GUEST SPEAKER

GEORGE VAUGHAN - CEREMONY E

George R. Vaughan is Director of Technology for the YTL Brabazon and Aviva Arena project currently being built in Bristol, where he leads the technology strategy for one of the UK's newest and most sustainable smart-city developments.

Over a career spanning more than three decades, he has delivered major digital transformation programmes across some of the UK's most recognised venues and destinations, including Twickenham Stadium and Ascot Racecourse. He is also the co-founder of The Digital Line (TDL), helping organisations harness technology to drive innovation and growth across health care, hospitality and entertainment.

Beyond his professional work, George is passionate about developing future talent, championing equality in technology and supporting initiatives that encourage young people to pursue careers in STEM. A regular speaker and writer on technology and innovation, he is committed to helping the next generation navigate an increasingly digital world, where the unique traits of human creativity, curiosity and critical thinking are more important than ever.

Fun Fact: Vaughan trekked to Everest Base Camp as part of a 24-person team and played in the highest-ever game of rugby - at over 5,500 meters - raising funds for Show Racism the Red Card and the RFU's Spire charity.



HONORARY GRADUAND

NEIL ASHLEY - CEREMONY F

Neil Ashley has enjoyed a distinguished career in UK and international construction and energy. Born in North Lincolnshire, he trained as a civil engineer and combined work with study, completing a BSc at Battersea College in 1958 while employed by the National Coal Board in Kent. He later gained a Diploma in Business and Financial Management from Ashridge Business School.

Neil worked on major projects with Costain and Consolidated Goldfields before joining Balfour Beatty plc, where he became Joint Managing Director in 1980. He led the company's overseas operations in more than 50 countries, establishing it as the UK's leading construction exporter and building a significant presence in the United States. In 1989 he oversaw the acquisition of ARC's construction business from Hanson plc, renaming it Amey plc, and served as Founder Chairman until his retirement in 2001. Under his leadership Amey floated

on the London Stock Exchange, subsequently entering the FTSE 250 with a market capitalisation of £1.4 billion.

He was Founding Chairman of Energy Power Resources Ltd, then Europe's largest private producer of non-fossil-fuel power, and a founding investor in Volvere plc, where he later served as Deputy Chairman. His public appointments have included Chair of CBI Southern England and National Council Member, Chair of Oxford University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust, and Senior Governor of Oxford Brookes University, which awarded him an Honorary Doctorate. Over the last two decades he has also supported numerous medical and educational charities as Patron, Sponsor and Trustee.

Neil's career reflects transformative leadership in infrastructure, energy and public service, exemplifying enterprise, social responsibility and impact at the highest level.



A LITTLE HISTORY

60 YEARS OF SURREY DEGREES

The University of Surrey was established on 9 September 1966 with the grant of its Royal Charter, but its roots go back to 1891, when its forerunner, Battersea Polytechnic Institute, was founded.

As its academic reputation grew, it was renamed Battersea College of Technology and moved to Guildford in the 1960s, where it became a university awarding its own degrees.

And degree conferment ceremonies like yours have been held at Guildford Cathedral since 1970.

The mace

The University mace was designed and crafted by Desmond Clen Murphy and used ceremonially for the first time at the Installation as Chancellor of the Rt Hon the Lord Robens of Woldingham in 1966.

The mace is made of silver and walnut wood, with the shield of the University coat of arms on its head in colour, and with the shields of the coat of arms of Surrey County Council, Guildford Borough Council and Battersea Polytechnic Institute engraved in silver underneath. The embroidered coat of arms on the mace table, carried out in metallic thread, French knots, applied leathers and various materials, was created by Christine Habib, a former student of the Hampton School of Embroidery.

The mace was presented to Guildford Cathedral for permanent display on 13 July 1997.



The arms of the University of Surrey

The University of Surrey coat of arms commemorates the University's move from London to Guildford. The woolpacks on the shield are taken from the arms of the Borough of Guildford, while the blue and gold chequers and mantling are from the arms of the former Earls of Surrey. The swords, an allusion to the arms of the City of London, are taken from the shield of Battersea Polytechnic.

The blazon of the University's coat of arms, which was granted in 1966, is topped by a stag resting its right leg on an upturned key. The stag denotes the medieval royal hunting park on which our leafy Stag Hill site has been developed, while the key is a heraldic symbol of learning.

The coat of arms is an elegant symbol of our reputation and standing.

ACADEMIC DRESS

Every university has a distinctive set of academic robes for the degrees it awards and special ceremonial robes for the high officers of the university. The blue brocade that features in the hoods of all our robes is unique to Surrey and distinguishes us from other universities.

GRADUATE ROBES

Undergraduate and masters degrees

Graduates wear a black gown and a black cloth mortar board. Hoods are usually fully lined with blue brocade and vary in design depending on whether the award is undergraduate or postgraduate.



Diploma and certificate awards

Diplomates wear a black gown and a black cloth mortar board. Postgraduate hoods are fully lined with blue brocade, with a plain white trim. Undergraduate hoods have a blue brocade and plain white trim.



Doctorate awards

Gowns are in cardinal red with blue brocade on the front facings. The hoods are cardinal red, fully lined with University brocade and have a ribbon trim rebated from the outside edge of the hood. The hat is a black cloth bonnet with red cord and tassels, with the exception of Doctors of Letters, Science and Medicine where the cord and tassels are gold.

The colour of the trim on the hoods denotes the type of degree:

Bachelor and Master of Arts, Doctor of Letters - Red ribbon

Bachelor, Master and Doctor of Education - Green ribbon

Bachelor, Master and Doctor of Engineering - Grey ribbon

Bachelor and Master of Laws - Purple ribbon

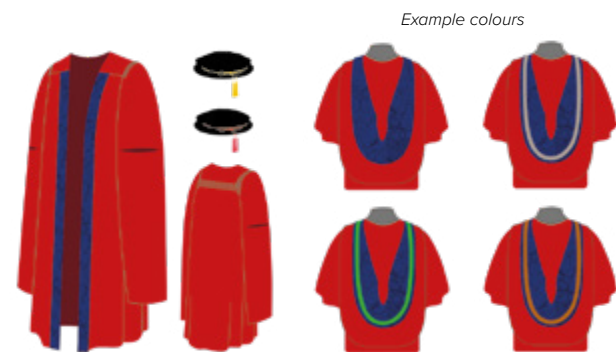
Bachelor and Master of Music - White brocade

Master of Business - Ruby ribbon
